### **Paul's First Missionary Journey**

- The people of Lystra thought Barnabas Zeus and Paul was Hermes (Acts 14)
- Jewish opposition followed Paul, stoned him, and left him for dead.

#### **Paul's Second Missionary Journey**

- Jerusalem council (Acts 15) ruled that Gentiles did not have to become Jewish
- Paul and Barnabas split ways because they disagreed about John Mark
- Paul wanted Timothy to go with him; so he took him and \_\_\_\_\_him because of the Jews who were in those places
  - 1 Corinthians 9:19-22 I have become all things to all people, so that I may by every possible means save some.
  - **Philippians 2:19-24** For I have no one else like-minded who will genuinely care about your interests

**Timothy written to / about...** Acts, 1 Corinthians, Philippians, 1 Thessalonians, 1 Timothy, 2 Timothy, Hebrews
